Note that Summit Bechtel Reserve does not use the lottery system. We are first-come, first-served. Your registration will be immediately finalized once the deposit is paid.

You have reviewed the eligibility for the SBR programs and made sure that those in your unit who are planning to attend meet all eligibility requirements.
You have reviewed several program and date offerings that your group is most interested in and prioritized your unit's preferences so that if one of the options is not available, you are ready to select an alternative.
You have read and understand SBR's cancellation policy: Please notify SBR immediately if your unit intends to cancel. The \$250 deposit per crew is non-refundable. SBR does not refund units for canceled flights or ground transportation. SBR strongly recommends trip insurance. Units are responsible for knowing and adhering to the payment schedule. Failure to submit on-time payment will result in cancellation.
You have read and understand BSA National High Adventure Bases set baseline pricing 12-24 months prior to attendance. Additional fuel, food, utilities, or other surcharges may be required based on economic conditions, increased costs, and other factors. If any such price change is implemented, the primary reservation contact will be notified directly, and a notice will be published on the registration page for affected adventures.
